Would you like to learn about salmon habitat while helping to restore streams for wild salmon?

Join Skagit Fisheries Enhancement Group for a free workshop to survey the availability of salmon spawning habitat and effectiveness of engineered structures at restoration sites. At this workshop you will learn how to document bankfull width, spawnable gravel, shade cover, pool formation, and other criteria to track changes in salmon habitat availability over time. This monitoring is crucial to determining the success of SFEG's restoration projects.

The first half of this workshop will be indoors, with outdoor practice in the afternoon. Volunteers will be asked to assist with monitoring at least one restoration site during June and July.
