



Skagit Fisheries Enhancement Group Education Internship Announcement Summer 2010

The Skagit Fisheries Enhancement Group (SFEG) is seeking applicants for a part time education intern position for the summer of 2010. SFEG is a nonprofit organization with the mission to build partnerships that educate and engage the community in habitat restoration and watershed stewardship activities in order to enhance salmonid populations.

Title: Education Intern

Reports to Outreach Coordinator

Job Summary:

The individual who fills this position will assist SFEG staff with education and outreach duties related to engaging the community in salmon habitat restoration. The primary task will be the development of an educational brochure about the stream ecosystem, salmon habitat, and stewardship of a large tributary of the Skagit River in the Sedro Woolley area.

Tasks:

- ◆ Assist staff in conducting education and outreach programs for youth and adults related to salmon enhancement and watershed stewardship
- ◆ Represent SFEG at various events in the Skagit Watershed to share information with the public about our work and recruit volunteers for future projects
- ◆ Assist Outreach Coordinator with developing content and layout of an educational brochure
- ◆ Use graphic design programs to create a draft brochure which can then be printed in a professional printing facility
- ◆ Assist with distribution of brochure to target audience

Qualifications:

- ◆ Must be proficient at graphics programs such as Power Point, Photoshop, and other design programs.
- ◆ Must have general knowledge of and/or interest in stream ecology, salmon biology and/or habitat requirements.
- ◆ Must be organized, motivated, and self-starting
- ◆ Must work well independently as well as part of a team

Time Commitment:

The intern will assist in the above tasks during the summer 2010. Timeline for completion is September 15, 2010. Time commitment will vary, but may average 10 hours per week.

Compensation:

A small stipend will be offered.
